About the Program

The Housing Authority of the County of Santa Cruz administers several rental and housing assistance programs designed to assist income eligible households. Participants in the Low Income Public Housing Program (LIPH) rent a townhouse style apartment owned and managed by the Housing Authority of the County of Santa Cruz. Tenants pay rent, which is equal to approximately 30% of



their household income.

The Apartment Complexes are located throughout the County. There are 6 complexes in Santa Cruz, 1 complex in Capitola, and 8 complexes in Watsonville. The complexes feature 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 bedroom units.

You may also obtain a Pre-Application form from our lobby during regular office hours, or you may request that a Pre-Application be mailed to you by calling (831) 454-5950. Prior to being housed, all tenants will need to pass an extensive screening process that includes but is not limited to a criminal background check, credit check, landlord reference check, and a current housekeeping check.
